Student Forms and Petitions: HASS Concentration Form

A Quick Guide for Students

Use the online HASS Concentration Form to propose a Humanities, Arts and Social Sciences (HASS) Concentration. All undergraduates must complete a HASS Concentration of 3-4 subjects (depending on the Concentration field). Students must select a HASS Concentration and submit a HASS Concentration proposal by the end of the first week of the second semester in their junior year.

0	The Student creates a proposal for his or her HASS Concentration and submits it to the HASS Concentration Advisor. The student should discuss the proposal with his or her HASS Concentration Advisor.
0	The HASS Concentration Advisor reviews the student's submitted proposal. The advisor may approve it or return it to the student for revision.
6	When the Student completes the subjects included in the proposal, he or she submits the form to the HASS Concentration Advisor for completion approval. The student should discuss the completion of the Concentration with his or her Concentration advisor.
0	The HASS Concentration Advisor reviews the student's submitted completion. The advisor may approve it or return it to the student for revision.

ONCE THE PROPOSAL HAS BEEN APPROVED

Once the proposal has been approved, you are now expected to fulfill the HASS Concentration subjects specified in your proposal. If you Add or Drop subjects in your approved proposal, you will need to update and resubmit your proposal. You should submit for completion approval when you have taken and passed the subjects proposed for your Concentration or when you are in your final term and are taking a proposed subject.



SUBMIT CONCENTRATION COMPLETION

Submit your HASS Concentration Form for completion approval once you have completed and have passing letter grades for the subjects proposed for your Concentration, or when you are in your final term and are taking a proposed subject.
